



## COMMUNITY-SUPPORTED FISHERY (CSF) CONSUMER CONTRACT

**THANK YOU** for your interest in the Walking Fish CSF. Please read this contract carefully, sign and date it, and mail it back to us with your payment.

### About your share:

The CSF begins Sept. 17 and runs until Dec. 10. *There will be no delivery on November 26 because of the Thanksgiving holiday.*

Those who purchase a weekly share will receive 12 deliveries; those who choose to buy a bi-weekly (every-other-week) share will receive 6 deliveries. Bi-weekly shares will be delivered on alternating weeks (one bi-weekly schedule will start on Sept. 17 and end Dec. 3; the other bi-weekly schedule will start on Sept. 24 and end Dec. 10).

Over the course of the CSF, you will receive a variety of locally caught seafood from Carteret County fishermen. The composition of each week's portion will vary depending on seasonal availability and weather conditions. Members can expect to receive such species as hard clams, shrimp, triggerfish, spot, mullet, flounder, and black drum.

Most fall deliveries will consist of fresh seafood, however you may receive frozen seafood when severe weather prohibits fishing or as part of your last delivery.

## 4. Taking your share home

- Shares can be picked up on Thursday from 4:00 to 6:00 pm at the public parking lot at the Sarah P. Duke Gardens off Anderson Street (directions are available on the website). *Please note: this is NOT the same day as the Mobile Market pick up.*
- If you are unable to pickup your share, please arrange for someone else to pick it up for you. For your convenience, there is a message board on our website in the Member's Forum page where you can swap/trade/buy shares from other members. Please make your arrangements directly with the other members. **Unclaimed shares cannot be stored or held for pick up due to their perishable nature.**
- Shares will be delivered to Durham in a mechanically refrigerated truck in accordance with all state and federal regulations. Your seafood will be kept refrigerated until you arrive. Different species will have different storage times, so please check the weekly email for any special handling instructions. We strongly recommend you place your seafood in a refrigerator (set as close to 32 degrees as possible) as soon as possible after pick up. We are not responsible for the safety of your seafood once it is in your possession.
- It is your responsibility to bring a small cooler or insulated bag to transport your seafood home. We will provide ice at the pick-up site.

## 5. Missed deliveries

North Carolina's weather is often unpredictable and there may be times when weather prevents fishing. If weather prohibits a fresh catch, we will either extend the number of deliveries or provide locally harvested frozen fish. If a pickup is cancelled or delayed, you will be notified as soon as possible.
